

Recommended methods for safe medication disposal

- **YEAR-ROUND PHARMACY DROP BOXES:** see below for list of available drop boxes in Lincoln, NE
- **IF YOU LIVE OUTSIDE OF LINCOLN-** These boxes are available across the state. For a location in your area, call NE Urology at 402.489.8888 ext 263 or visit <https://www.nebraskameds.org/> for locations near you.
- **DEA TAKE-BACK DAYS:** The DEA sponsors National Prescription Drug Take Back Days twice a year, offering temporary collection sites nationwide.
- **Mail-back programs:** Some pharmacies and local governments offer pre-paid, pre-addressed envelopes for mailing back unwanted medicines.

Year-round drug take-back boxes are available at various pharmacy locations throughout Lincoln, NE. **The Nebraska MEDS Coalition partners with over 300 pharmacies statewide for medication disposal**, and many Walgreens and Walmart locations also feature permanent drop boxes.

How to use drug take-back boxes

Drop-off is free and anonymous.

Most locations accept both prescription and over-the-counter medications.

Some locations accept liquids under 4 ounces if contained in a sealed bag.

Do not dispose of illegal drugs, needles, syringes, or sharps containers in these boxes.
