- YEAR-ROUND PHARMACY DROP BOXES: see below for list of available drop boxes in Lincoln, NE
- IF YOU LIVE OUTSIDE OF LINCOLN- These boxes are available across the state. For a location in your

  you.
- DEA TAKE-BACK DAYS: The DEA sponsors National Prescription Drug Take Back Days twice a year, offering temporary collection sites nationwide.
- **Mail-back programs:** Some pharmacies and local governments offer pre-paid, pre-addressed envelopes for mailing back unwanted medicines.

Year-round drug take-back boxes are available at various pharmacy locations throughout Lincoln, NE. **The Nebraska MEDS Coalition partners with over 300 pharmacies statewide for medication disposal,** and many Walgreens and Walmart locations also feature permanent drop boxes.
